At this time, we would like to remind everyone to follow the guidelines set by the CDC.

At a Minimum, please follow these guidelines:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching any part of your head until after washing your hands.
- Avoid close contact with those who are or appear to be sick.
- Keep a good distance, about 6 feet, from other people.
- Keep clean, with disinfectant, objects and surfaces.
- Stay at home and away from others if YOU are sick with a cold or flu or other.
- Cover your mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing, then dispose of the tissue and wash your hands.
- Do not attend events if YOU are sick or have symptoms that might mean you might be sick. This includes Church, movies, dining out, the gym any place with others.

### Sea Ray Boat Manufacturing Facility Tour, April 6, 2020

This tour is currently **closed**, but we are keeping a wait list for potential substitutions if cancellations occur. We will also likely schedule another tour to this venue in future months, so keep an eye on the *TellicoLife* Event Calendar for TVCUC if you are interested.

Sea Ray designs, manufactures and markets boats ranging from 17-foot (5.2 m) power cruisers to over 65-foot (20 m) yachts, including the Sundancer brand and, starting in 2014, the "L" Series luxury yachts. Sea Ray is based in Knoxville, Tennessee and it operates two factories in Tennessee and two in Florida. Sea Ray designs and markets more than 40 models ranging in boats from 18 to 65 feet (5.5 to 19.8 m).

Sea Ray was the first boat manufacturer to use fiberglass in its pleasure boat construction, and it also pioneered the molded-in swim platform when it launched Ski Ray ski boats in 1991.

### MasterCraft Boat Manufacturing Facility Tour, April 7, 2020

MasterCraft was founded in 1968 when it built its first ski boat in a two-stall horse barn on a farm in Maryville, Tennessee. Dissatisfied with the large wakes and pull of other ski boats, MasterCraft builders designed a hull that had the smallest wake in the industry; smooth and low at slalom and jump speeds; well defined at trick speeds.

In its first year of operation, MasterCraft only built 12 boats. But the boat design was so revolutionary that the company began getting order after order for its boats and MasterCraft soon became recognized as a major force in the tournament ski boat market. Fast forward forty-five years later, MasterCraft is producing thousands of tournament ski, wakeboarding, luxury and performance boats annually to keep up with consumer demand.

MasterCraft has a single manufacturing facility located in Vonore, Tennessee, where it employs over 400 people. These "MasterCraftsmen" descend on Lake Tellico every morning dedicated to hand-building the world's best boats. MasterCraft engineers listen to the consumer's wants and needs, develop new ideas, and mix humanity with technology in order to produce the next generation of MasterCraft boats. This constant evaluation and focus on the customer have made the soul of the company more attuned to rider and skier needs with each passing year.

MasterCraft is by far the largest producer of inboard ski, wakeboard and luxury performance powerboats in the world. It sells boats in over 30 different countries and has over 130 domestic and international dealers.

Members Are Invited To Join A Limited Space Tour Of The Loudon County 911 Emergency Call Center In Knoxville On August 3, 2020

Loudon County E-911 is the primary PSAP, or Public Safety Answering Point, for all of Loudon County, Tennessee. The dispatch center currently serves over 40,000 citizens with an annual call volume of over 55,000 calls providing the following services:

911 Call Taking

EMD (Emergency Medical Dispatching)

Police Dispatch

Fire Dispatch

EMS Dispatch.

911 is the emergency phone number to call for help in a police, fire or medical emergency. The 9-1-1 calls go over dedicated networks to the appropriate 9-1-1 answering point (PSAP) for your location, and our trained personnel will send the emergency help needed.

Members Are Invited to Join A Limited Space Tour of The Proton Therapy Center In Knoxville On March 14, 2020. (above.)



TAP volunteers continue working hard to deliver refurbished computer systems to deserving youth in area schools. The demand remains high and, as of March 10<sup>th</sup> this year, TAP has delivered 202 systems assisting at least 120 youth. The number of students helped from systems already delivered increases monthly, as reporting by schools and agencies for 45 systems delivered last year and 82 systems delivered this year continues. 

While you can use iMovie or Photos to create slideshows, Keynote is probably the most advanced tool with the most options. You can quickly import many photos onto individual slides. Then you can work with each slide to scale and adjust each photo. You can add text and transitions. You can even create a Ken Burns effect by moving and scaling a photo over time. Once you have perfected your slideshow, you can export it as a video to share. You can also record "narration" to include in the video.
